North Devon and Torrington Community Safety Partnership is the joint crime and disorder reduction partnership (ODRP), also known as the community safety partnership (CSP) for both North Devon and Torrington districts.

The agencies that make up North Devon and Torrington Community Safety Partnership include:

- Devon and Somerset Fire and Rescue Service
- Devon County Council
- Torrington District Council
- Dorset, Devon and Cornwall Community Rehabilitation Company

North Devon and Torrington Community Safety Partnership has daily partnership meetings where issues of anti-social behaviour are discussed, along with any alcohol related crime and domestic abuse. This approach allows us to offer timely and effective solutions to issues. This ensures that partners work closely together, rather than in isolation.

We also meet regularly and work closely to consider wider issues, such as crime prevention, and how together we can respond to local issues and improve quality of life for residents.

Anti-Social Behaviour

Anti-social behaviour is a term used to describe the day-to-day incidents of crime, nuisance and disorder that can make some people's lives a misery. This includes:

- littering
- vandalism
- public drunkenness
- aggressive dogs
- noisy or abusive neighbours
- rowdy behaviour
- Intimidating, offensive and threatening behaviour
- hoax calls
